

## **ANDY LUTTER –**

pianist – composer – arr.

Took up classical studies at the age of eleven. After taken his Abitur, Lutter studied Jazz piano at the Munich School of Jazz, the Berklee School of Music and under Walter Norris in Berlin.

Studied composition at the Munich Richard Strauss conservatory.

Founded the Andy Lutter Jazztrio in 1985. The trio made its CD début with Nicht endende Geschichten (released under Extra Records)

Composed and performed with a number of groups including Four Stressmen (free fusion music and ballads), the Nasrudin orchestra (world music), Three Dames & James (a musical parody / revue of music through the ages).

Lutter has written, and performed, compositions and arrangements while also working as musical director in the production of numerous plays and musicals in the German-speaking world such as Jesus Christ Superstar, Sweet Charity, Hello Dolly, Into the Woods, and the Rocky Horror Picture Show.

As a highly sought after studio keyboarder, Lutter has performed and recorded with some of today's leading film score composers such as Jerry Goldsmith, Mike Gibbs, John Scott and others.

Lutter works and lives in Munich. He writes music and songs, plays with small Ensembles and with Orchestras (Radio Orchestra Munich).

In his Studio he records CDs and Music for films.
